Maggiano's to open third Houston location this month

The third Houston location of Maggiano's Little Italy is set to open Aug. 29.

The Memorial City Mall restaurant broke ground in late 2015, the Houston Business Journal previously reported. The new restaurant was part of a complete redesign of the west end of the mall, a representative of Memorial City's developer, Houston-based MetroNational, told HBJ in January.

The 8,864-square-foot restaurant will include a patio and two "flex rooms," according to the Houston Press.

This will be the third Maggiano's location in Houston. The most recent location opened in the expanded Baybrook Mall late last year, and the other location is at 2019 Post Oak Blvd. in the Galleria area. Maggiano's opened its first Houston location in 2008.

Maggiano's is owned by Dallas-based Brinker International Inc. (NYSE: EAT), which also owns Chili's Grill & Bar.

The first Maggiano's opened in Chicago in 1991, and Brinker bought the concept in 1995. The chain now has 51 locations in 22 states and the District of Columbia.

The Memorial City location will be open from 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Thursday, from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m. on Friday and Saturday, and from noon to 9 p.m. on Sunday, according to Maggiano's website.
