Dallas-based Z Resorts LLC has revealed the global-inspired designs behind 12 luxury suites on the 10th floor of Hotel ZaZa Memorial City, which will open Dec. 1.

The suites, which range from 471 square feet to 966 square feet, were designed by Dallas-based Duncan Miller Ullmann Design, according to a statement. The 159-room hotel will have more than 13,000 square feet of meeting and event space, as well as a signature restaurant and lounge dubbed The Tipping Point, according to the statement.

Z Resorts LLC partnered with Houston-based **MetroNational** in a third-party management deal to build Houston's second Hotel ZaZa. The 17-story hotel broke ground in October 2015 at 9787 Katy Freeway at the intersection of Interstate 10 and Bunker Hill. It will include luxury residences available for rent on the top floors.

Ian Bush, the current general manager at Hotel ZaZa in the Museum District, is transitioning to the general manager role at the Hotel ZaZa in Memorial City.

Houston's Kirksey Architecture designed the mixed-use project, which is being built by Anslow Bryant Construction.
